Philadelphia Jazz Project, and her own band. Her original albums, *Are You Ready* (2004), and *Time & Space* (2010) are described as a "signature mix of jazz, R&B, hip hop and soul" (Boston Globe). Her release *Wawa* (2020), "grooving and addictive jawn" (Allaboutjazz.com) garnered international press. Local venues include World Cafe Live, Cedar Park Jazz, and WHYY's House Concert Series online. Her most recent tracks *Thank You* (2022) and Away (2023) - with Camden MC The Authentic - are on all streaming services. Gretchen Elise: Extended Bio 391 words 2489 ch

Gretchen Elise is a West Philadelphian jazz vocalist, band leader and songwriter since the age of seven: "A damn good songwriter with a unique ability to connect to audiences" (Homer Jackson, Philadelphia Jazz Project). Her catchy music has a multigenerational appeal and helps to bridge the gap between jazz and other genres. Her talents are broad: she was a champion gymnast and choreographer until shifting back to music as her main focus. She debuted her first jazz composition with Bouzouki and West African drums for a World Music Orchestra in Berlin at age 24.

Private study with Berklee's late, Latin Jazz vocalist, Mili Bermejo in the early 2000's helped to shape Gretchen's approach to jazz. Concurrently, she developed an award-winning drum-making curriculum, earning an M.Ed. in Arts in Education at Harvard. Her study with The Vocal Scientist, Owen Brown that began in 2022 is helping to launch her to her next stage of artistry.

Original jazz compositions include: recordings with MPB singer João Marcos (2003); eponymous albums Are You Ready (2004) and Time and Space (2010). PJP commissioned her to pen a "Sun-Ra-inspired" version of the Roots/Erykah Badu's "You Got Me" and lyrics to Alphonzo Johnson's Involuntary Bliss (2014), and released her "Hot"on PJP Mixtape #1 (2014). Her single Wawa (2020, co-prod. Doug Grigsby) landed on Allaboutjazz.com's Top 20 of 2020 list.

Losing Doug (Grigsby, d. 2021) propelled Gretchen to write poetry and shift her career towards what he dubbed her "beautiful music." She followed with Birds Still Sing WHYY/ NPR (2021), jazz-nudisco video Thank You (2022) and a feature on jazz -hip hop The Authentic's Away (2023).

A consummate connector, Gretchen speaks 6 languages and was dubbed "Woman around Town" (West Philly Local) for community leadership. She coordinated the PJP's vocalist collective DivaNation PHILLY, raised \$500K for 100 music and arts projects and

led campaigns to save instrumental music in Phila. Schools. She garnered the 2019 GPCA Pre-K Arts & Culture Award and is designing a multi-generational music series for the West Phila nonprofit UCD (2023).
